Located at 2600 De La Cruz Blvd, Santa Clara, Graphic Packaging Holding Company announced in September 2017 that it would close the Santa Clara recycled paperboard mill which produced 400 tons per day of clay coated box board paper products. An open house inspection is scheduled on Tuesday and Wednesday, January 30th and 31st from 9 am to 4 pm.
